

Resko Faculty Research and Mentoring Achievement Award 2019

The John A. Resko Faculty Research and Mentoring Achievement Award recognizes a faculty member for outstanding research and student mentoring. Nominations are solicited for members of the School of Medicine Graduate Faculty who have a sustained record of high quality research as well as a strong record of mentoring graduate students and/or postdoctoral fellows in their laboratories and subsequent careers.

Nomination packets should include a letter summarizing the candidate's research and mentoring accomplishments, the candidate's curriculum vitae, and a list of mentored students and postdoctoral fellows including their current positions. The most competitive nomination packets typically include supporting letters from faculty colleagues and from current and past students. Nominations should be sent to the OHSU GS Portal at <https://www.surveymonkey.com/r/2019GSAwards> and must be received no later than Friday, **April 5, 2019**.
