**For the 2012-13 academic year, there were no Black or African American students in the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> year classes in the School of Medicine. During that year, there were 4 Black or African American students out of a student body of 554 students (0.72%). If the number of Black or African American students in the School of Medicine that year equaled the approximate percentage of the Black or African American population in the City of Portland (6.4%), there would have been 36 Black or African American students.**

**For the 2014-15 academic year, there were 6 Black or African American students in the School of Medicine's student body of 575 (1.04%). Were the student body to mirror the City of Portland for this academic year, 37 Black or African American students would be enrolled.**

**In the entering classes of 2008, 2009, 2010, 2011, 2012, 2015, no Black or African American man matriculated in the School of Medicine MD programs.**
