The Oath of Geneva

At the time of being admitted as a member
of the medical profession:

I solemnly pledge myself to consecrate my life to the
service of humanity;

I will give to my teachers the respect and
gratitude which is their due;

I will practice my profession with
conscience and dignity;

The health of my patient will be my
first consideration;

I will respect the secrets which are
confided in me;

I will maintain by all means in my power,
the honor and the noble traditions of the medical profession;
my colleagues will be my brothers and sisters.

I will not permit considerations of religion,
nationality, race, party politics or social standing
to intervene between my duty and my patient;

I will maintain the utmost respect for human life,
even under threat;

I will not use my medical knowledge contrary
to the laws of humanity.

I make these promises solemnly, freely and upon my honor.

Inclusion in this program does not, by itself, denote proof of graduation from OHSU. Graduates named in this program either completed degrees at OHSU in the period of July 1, 2015 – June 17, 2016, or are recommended by their school to satisfy minor degree requirements by September 1, 2016. Graduates in Clinical Laboratory Science, Dietetic Internship, Paramedic Education, Radiation Therapy and Physician Assistant Programs are scheduled to complete their programs by December 31, 2016.
